Charles McKenzie, chairman of the Committee of Arrangements reported the following recommendations which were adopted: That the following order be adopted, subject to such changes as may need to be made during its progress; that the morning sessions begin at 9 o'clock A. M. and close at 12:30 P. M.: that the afternoon sessions begin at 2 o'clock and close at 5; that the evening sessions begin at 7:30 o'clock, that the first half hour each morning be spent in devotional exercises; that the Synod accept the invitation of the Colonial Club to its reception on Wednesday evening. The thanks of Synod, expressed by a rising vote, were tendered the retiring Moderator for his able and stimulating sermon this evening. After prayer, Synod adjourned until Wednesday morning at nine o'clock. Wednesday, October 20, 9 o'clock, A. M. The Synod met and spent...
