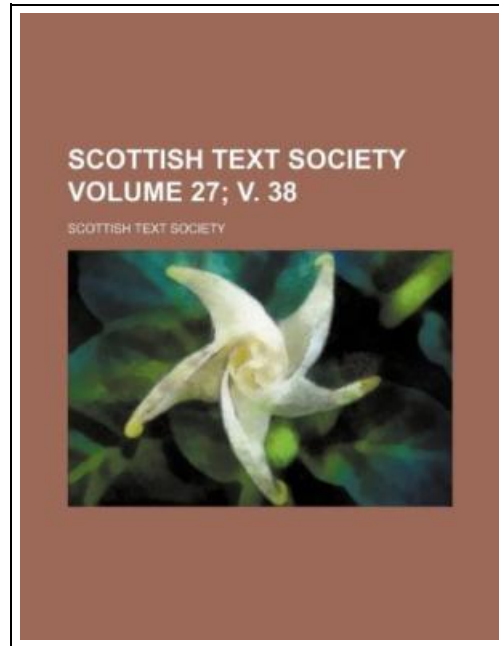

This is a rare meaning of the verb, found mostly in Northern works. Cf. Life of St Cuthbert, 1. 2003--The woman rase as it wer fra slepe, And come Cuthbert forto kepe. 180, 181. On the gate, on the way; atyate, at the gate. An interesting note on the two nouns will be found s. v. Gate, in the Errata to Skeats Dictionary, ed. 1882. 184.
